Botley is being pushed too far.

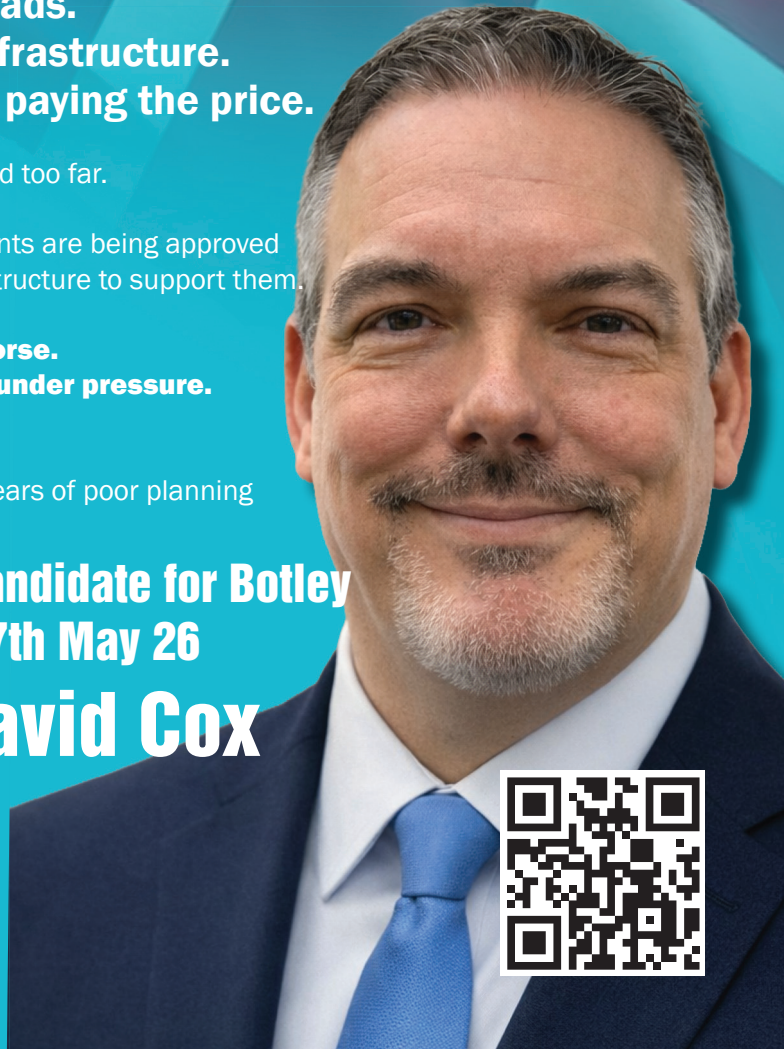
Too many developments are being approved
