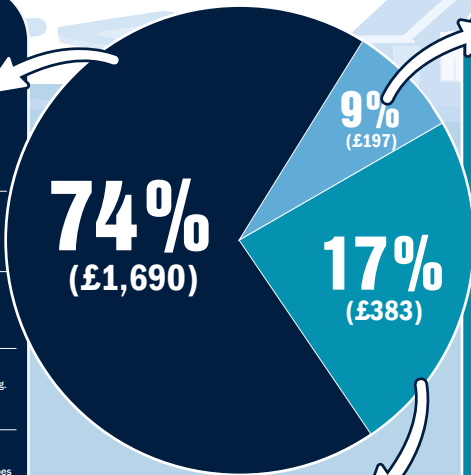

The biggest share, but are we getting value for it?

- Adult Social Care 45%** The biggest share of your council tax. But are we getting value for money?
- Children's Social Care 23%** Protecting children & supporting families. How do we know this investment is working?
- Highways 4%** Maintaining roads & street lighting. Why do our roads still have so many potholes?
- School Transport 6.4%** Getting children to school. Why does transport cost more than supporting education?
